On Your iPad

To connect to your desktop as a <u>host</u> with the iPad, you must first open the Splashtop application on the iPad.

Tap on the Splash Top icon



When SplashTop opens, tap on the settings (gear icon) in the upper right hand side

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Make sure Use Splashtop Center is on – green means on. If it is off you will need to turn it on to use the Spashtop Application.

When you enter in your credentials, select "Log in"

Your screen will show you your computer name, then select your computer (Note that your computer name will be different than shown)



When you select your computer, you will be given two options



Selecting "Host a shared session" will bring up the QR code that students can take a picture of or enter the 4 digit pin to connect to your computer. You will automatically be added to the session as the host. This is what you want to use if you wish to share your computer screen in a session with your students.

Selecting "Connect 1 to 1" will connect your iPad to the desktop as the only user, as if you were using remote desktop. This session is private and nobody else can enter and only you can see your PC
